Choice Board (Choose one) - Due October 25th

<p>Create a map of the town or place where the story takes place (setting.) Give specific details. Include a paragraph that describes your map drawing.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>	<p>Research a topic (person, thing, idea, event, etc.) brought up in your book. Share the new information you found in a short (3 – 5 minute) presentation to the class -</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>	<p>Free write your thoughts, emotional reaction to the events or people in the book. This is personal response to what you have read. It must be at least one full page.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>
<p>Draw a favorite part from the book – don't copy an already existing illustration. Write a good detailed paragraph (for instance advertising the book) about your drawing.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>	<p>MAKING REAL-LIFE CONNECTIONS What do you have in common with the characters in the story? Include personal traits, physical traits, actions, family situations, etc.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>	<p>Create a "Wanted" Poster for the villain in your story. Explain their dirty deed and why they are wanted as well as a physical description. Give specific details.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>
<p>Create an advertisement for your book. This should include a poster that draws the audience into the story. Your poster should have characters, settings & background information. Include a summary to "hook" your audience.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>	<p>Create a diorama that depicts a scene from your book. Include a paragraph that gives the observer details to help them understand the scene.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>	<p>Create a comic strip for a new scene in the book. You must include dialogue that is appropriate for the characters/setting/plot.</p> <hr/> <p align="center">Title of book</p>
